How To Rig a TroutBead Set Up






Bead to Hook Size Ratio

First you need your supplies: A package of TB-Peggz (color of your choice), BeadHooks weights, TroutBeads (size, color and style of your choice) light leader material and a strike indicator

The Pegging Method



String the TroutBead through the line and tie on your BeadHook. Pick your desired length between the hook and the bead (it is recommended not to be more than 2 inches) and insert a TB-Peggz. Adjust as needed and trim the excess.

Add a few split shot or weight of your choice, roughly 14 to 18 inches from the bead.

Add your strike indicator by sliding it on the line and Affixing it with another TB-Peggz. Keep some of the excess sticking out to be able to adjust as necessary.

Your strike indicator should be about 1 to $1-\frac{1}{2}$ times the depth of the water.

Your leader material should be the lightest possible and 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ times the depth of the water.

You want to just lightly tap bottom.

The BeadKnot Method

1. Run your leader through the TroutBead and back over and around again, so you've gone Through twice.

2. Wrap the hook end through the hoop 7 or 8 times.

3. Pull tight and the wraps will disappear into the bead hole.

4. Finished product with TroutBead approximately 2 inches from the BeadHook

* Same process with the Pegging Method, once your bead is affixed to the line.

There is no right or wrong way of affixing the bead to the line it is simply a matter of preference.
